Our Year 4 students in Rooms 6, 10 and 11 will be visiting Karakariki Camp to enjoy an outdoor, overnight camp experience on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November, Week 6 - Term 4.

We travel to and from Karakariki by car.

The cost for the camp will be \$85. This includes accommodation, meals, camp duties, an activity fee and qualified instructor for the rope climb.

Meals are catered for, including those people who require special dietary requirements. Children will need to bring their lunch on the first day for our hike.
